## Erratum

In the article titled, "Changes in Rates of Capture and Demographics of *Myotis septentrionalis* (Northern Long-eared Bat) in Western Virginia before and after Onset of White-nose Syndrome" published in *Northeastern Naturalist* Volume 23, Issue 2, the rates of capture referenced throughout the article as bats/m<sup>2</sup>/h was mislabeled. Personal communication on 16 February 2021 between Virgil Brack, Jr. (Environmental Solutions and Innovations, Inc., Cincinnati, OH) and the corresponding author, lead to the determination that the rate of capture, bats/m<sup>2</sup>/h, when applied, lead to capture rates far higher than expected. After reviewing the data used to determine the capture rate, it was discovered that the capture rate should have been labeled mean capture rates per night, adjusted for area of net and sampling duration (bats/night).
