Also co-published with the *Caribbean Naturalist* (ISSN #2326-7119), an online publication that extends our coverage of natural history research to the waters, coastal areas and islands of the Caribbean region, and the *Urban Naturalist* (ISSN # 2328-8965), an online publication covering natural history research in urban, suburban, and other areas of impacted by major human development.
